POLAROID IMAGE AND EMULSION TRANSFERS

You have asked for it and now it is finally here! Students will learn the process for doing Polaroid and Emulsion Transfers from our their own 4" x 5" or 4" x 6" photos or digital collages. Students will use the Daylab CopySystem to project the image onto the Polaroid Film, then manipulate in either style. The images will be transferred onto watercolor papers, silk, or wood. These machines allow students to do spontaneous collages without glue. The Polaroid Image Transfer gives you an ethereal dreamy look while the Polaroid Emulsion Transfer comes with its own attitude and wavy wedges that you dictate. Class fee includes some supplies, i.e., notebook with instructions, tips and resources, receptor materials (paper, silk, and wood), and film. Students will need to bring several 4" x 5" or 4" x 6" images to use for transfers along with a fine Sharpie pen. Bringing both color and black and white will result in a different look. Photos that are inkjet or laser printed transparencies, thin tissue paper, or vellum can be used for layering. Students will fall in love with the magical and creative process and will have several images to admire, ready to frame, use in a collage, altered book, or journal. The process does not hurt your original image. Register early and come have some fun!
